**TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND ORDER SETTING HEARING FOR
INJUNCTIVE RELIEF**

After considering Plaintiffs' application for temporary restraining order and application for temporary injunction, this Court finds there is evidence that harm is imminent to Plaintiffs, and if the Court does not issue the temporary restraining order and set a hearing for Plaintiffs' application for temporary injunction, Plaintiffs will be irreparably injured.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that City of Houston, its agents, servants, employees, contractors, contract employees, attorneys, and those acting in concert with or in representation of City of Houston refrain from:

- (1) Changing, altering, destroying or modifying the debris field in the 4500-4600 blocks of Steffani Lane that is related to the explosion that occurred on January 24, 2020, at the Watson Grinding facility that is located at 4525 Gessner Road, Houston, Texas 77041.

The Clerk is ordered to issue notice to Defendants that the hearing on Plaintiffs' Application for Temporary Injunction is set for February 7, 2020, at 11:00 (a.m.)/p.m.

The purpose of the hearing shall be to determine whether this temporary restraining order should be made a temporary injunction pending a full trial on the merits.

Sets bond at \$ 500.⁰⁰

This Order expires on February 8, 2020, or upon further order of the Court or agreement of the parties.
